SERMON NOTES

I. HOPE BASED ON GOD'S WORD

- A. Part of "God with Us" is the written Word that He has left us. (Ps. 139:7–12)
- B. "God with Us" means that He always will be with us, and **nothing** can take that away!
- C. How we can rekindle hope through the reading of God's Word.

II. HOPE BASED ON GOD'S CHARACTER

- A. Bold hope and a small **action** resulted in life change. (Mk. 5:25–34)
- B. Because God is true to His character—who He is—we can take hope in Him. (Mk. 28:20)
- C. How we can rekindle hope through our understanding of God's character.

III. HOPE BASED ON GOD'S FAITHFULNESS

- A. Jeremiah understood that there is hope in the future when we **remember** what God has done in the past. (La. 3:21–26)
- B. Gratitude breeds hope. Thankfulness fosters hope. Acknowledgment and appreciation bring hope.
- C. How we can rekindle hope by focusing on gratitude for God's past blessings.
