SERMON OUTLINE

HE SEEKS THE LOST WITH PURPOSE

A. The Route: Jesus chooses to pass through Samaria, crossing cultural and social barriers (vv. 1–4)

B. The Encounter: He **initiates** conversation with a Samaritan woman at the well (vv. 5-7)

C. The Shock: His willingness to engage exposes both her need and His mission (vv. 8–9)

HE OFFERS LIVING WATER FOR THE SOUL

A. The Gift: Jesus speaks of living water that satisfies forever (vv. 10–14)

B. The Misunderstanding: She focuses on physical needs while He addresses spiritual thirst (vv. 11–15)

C. The Exposure: Jesus reveals her broken past to awaken her deeper **need** (vv. 16–18)

HE REVEALS TRUE WORSHIP AND HIS IDENTITY

A. The Question: She shifts to worship, seeking clarity about where and how to worship (vv. 19–20)

B. The Truth: Jesus defines worship as spirit and truth, not location or ritual (vv. 21-24)

C. The Revelation: Jesus openly declares Himself as the **Messiah** (vv. 25–26)

COME TO THE SAVIOR WHO SEEKS AND SATISFIES

Where are you still trying to satisfy your soul with temporary things, and what would it look like this week to come honestly to Jesus, receive His living water, and worship Him in spirit and truth?
