SERMON OUTLINE

THE STORM REVEALS HUMAN FEAR

A. The Withdrawal: Jesus departs as the crowd seeks to control Him (v. 15)

B. The Separation: The disciples move ahead without Jesus (vv. 16–17a)

C. The Storm: The sea grows rough and **threatening**
(vv. 17b–18)

JESUS APPROACHES IN DIVINE AUTHORITY

A. The Struggle: The disciples strain against the wind (v. 19a)

B. The Appearance: Jesus comes walking on the sea (v. 19b)

C. The Assurance: “It is I; do not be afraid” (v. 20)

JESUS BRINGS PEACE AND DELIVERANCE

A. The Reception: The disciples willingly receive Him into the boat (v. 21a)

B. The Resolution: The storm no longer controls the outcome, the One in control does

C. The Arrival: Immediately they reach their destination (v. 21b)

RESPOND TO HIS PRESENCE: TRUST HIM IN YOUR STORM

When the winds rise and fear takes hold, will you keep striving in your own strength—or will you receive Jesus, trust His presence, and rest in His power to carry you through?
