SERMON OUTLINE

THEY STUMBLE OVER HIS CLAIM, MISSING HIS SOURCE

A. The Complaint: The crowd grumbles at Jesus' claim to have come down from heaven (vv. 41–42)

B. The Misunderstanding: They judge Him by **earthly** familiarity rather than divine origin (v. 42)

C. The Clarification: True understanding comes only as the Father draws and reveals (vv. 43–46)

HE DECLARES HIMSELF THE ONLY SOURCE OF LIFE

A. The Promise: Whoever believes has eternal life (v. 47)

B. The Identity: Jesus is the Bread of life, greater than the manna in the wilderness (vv. 48–50)

C. The Provision: His flesh, given for the life of the world, **secures** true life (v. 51)

HE CALLS FOR PERSONAL, DEPENDENT FAITH

A. The Tension: The crowd struggles with His teaching about eating His flesh (v. 52)

B. The Meaning: To eat and drink is to fully trust, receive, and depend on Him (vv. 53–56)

C. The Result: Those who **abide** in Him share in His life now and forever (vv. 57–59)

RECEIVE THE BREAD THAT TRULY SATISFIES

Where are you trying to find life, satisfaction, or security apart from Christ, and what would it look like this week to depend fully on Him as your only source of life?
